Sir,

In continuation to this Ministry's letter of intent of even number dated 22.6.2006 and with reference to your letter dated 22.6.2006, I am directed to convey the approval of the Central Government for the increase of seats in MBBS from 100 to 150 at Mamata Medical College, Khammam by Mamata Educational Society with prospective effect i.e. from the academic year 2006-07 under Section 10(A) of IMC Act, 1956, as amended.


2. This permission of the Central Government for increase of seats and admission of students against the increased intake is initially for a period of one year subject to renewal on annual basis on achievement of annual targets set out in the project report and verification thereto by the Medical Council of India. The College shall not admit more than one batch of students against this letter of permission on the increased intake. The college shall also apply to Medical Council of India for renewal of permission against the increased intake well before the commencement of next academic session. While applying for such renewal, the achievement in terms of infrastructure, staff and equipment as spelt out in the time bound action plan and as required by Medical Council of India norms must be clearly indicated. The next batch of students against the increased intake shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Central Government.

3. The permission is, however, subject to the condition that the bank guarantee of Rs. 1.00 crore furnished by the college authorities against the increased intake is found to be in order in all respect. The admission process for the academic year 2006-07 has to be completed in accordance with the time schedule indicated in the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997, as amended.


